

REPORT OF MENTORING

At VSIT, we offer an exceptional mentoring program designed to support students in both their personal and academic development. Through a combination of various sessions, students (mentees) are guided by their teachers (mentors) to build essential skills such as confidence, time management, and stress management. The program was established to help students navigate key decisions related to their careers, professional courses, and to address academic and social challenges. Mentors provide a supportive and unbiased perspective, empowering mentees to make informed decisions and maintain a positive outlook, even when facing difficulties. In cases where issues are urgent or require specialized assistance, mentors may recommend that the mentee consult the campus counsellor for additional support. This holistic approach ensures that students have the resources and guidance they need to thrive. During this academic year, mentoring sessions were held weekly for all mentees collectively. These sessions covered various topics, including career opportunities and exam preparation strategies. To create a relaxed and engaging atmosphere, mentees were encouraged to participate in activities such as singing songs, playing musical instruments, speaking on topics of their choice, or sharing their views on current issues. These activities helped mentees feel more comfortable and fostered better familiarity among them. In addition to the group mentoring sessions, individual mentoring was provided to students identified as either slow learners or advanced learners.

Some mentees were found to be performing below the class average, and the mentoring sessions played a key role in identifying the reasons behind their underperformance. Through personalized mentoring, these students received guidance and support to overcome their learning challenges. On the other hand, high-performing students were identified and encouraged to explore preparation for competitive exams like CAT, MAT, UPSC, etc. The mentoring sessions also focused on developing essential soft skills, such as personal, language, and social skills, and motivating mentees to participate in various competitions.

The mentoring process was organized as follows: mentors were assigned their mentees via email, and a hard copy of the mentoring handbook was provided to collect relevant student data. All interactions were conducted with confidentiality.

The mentoring process was divided into two parts: first, a group activity conducted by mentors for the entire batch once a month, where fun activities were organized to break the ice. The second part involved one-on-one interactions with mentees, also held monthly.

If any mentee was identified as having significant issues that required personal counseling, the mentor would email the mentoring in-charge with the student's details (name, course, roll number). These students were then monitored and provided further assistance as directed by the mentoring committee. After each session, mentors updated attendance records and the mentoring handbook, as per the committee's guidelines.



Some of the issues shared by the mentees personally and in common:

Mental Health Concern:

Some mentees expressed feelings of mental distress, citing the emotional impact of having separated parents. **Family-related Distraction:**

Another mentee shared that she struggles to focus on her studies due to a sense of isolation within her family.

• Mathematics Difficulties:

A few students experienced difficulty grasping certain concepts in mathematics and accounts

Solutions for the issues shared by the mentees personally and in common:

· Recorded Videos for Missed Classes:

The recorded videos of the online classes were shared with students to help them catch up on lessons missed due to illness.

• Psychological Support Referral:

Mentees experiencing emotional challenges were encouraged to seek support from the college counsellor.

• Additional Classes for Math Support:

Extra sessions were organized for students struggling to understand certain mathematics and accounts topics.

Throughout the year, the campus counsellor, Dr. Kirti Potkar, conducted several mentoring sessions for students aimed at helping them prepare effectively for the upcoming semester. These sessions focused on guiding mentees in setting academic, personal, and professional goals, creating effective schedules, and developing strategies for managing time and stress. The mentoring addressed key areas essential for a successful semester, with a strong emphasis on goal-setting, time management, and stress management. In addition, Ms. Prathma Nemane led Sound Healing Workshops for students, offering a transformative experience through the use of vibrational medicine. These workshops provided participants with practical tools and insights to improve their physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being. By exploring the therapeutic power of sound vibrations, students discovered new methods of self-care, stress relief, and personal growth, fostering a deeper connection to themselves and their surroundings.

In the academic year began with a session organized by the Mentoring Committee for new faculty members, with around 25-30 faculty members in attendance. The session was engaging, with Dr. Kirti Potkar, the campus counsellor, leading a discussion about the challenges faced by department heads in mentoring students. Faculty members shared various concerns based on their observations and interactions with students, particularly noting a lack of motivation to study and the difficulty in engaging with mentees.

Following a brainstorming session, Dr. Kirti Potkar suggested several activities and techniques to help mentors overcome these challenges. She recommended exploring new teaching methods and incorporating edutainment—an approach that combines education with entertainment—to make learning more engaging. Dr. Kirti Potkar also suggested organizing subject-specific sessions where students could be given leadership opportunities, as leadership roles tend to increase participation and foster better integration of concepts. Additionally, she advised department heads on effective ways to manage their teams, such as setting clear boundaries, accepting individual differences, assigning tasks based on strengths, addressing disengaged or silent team members, and providing sufficient space and time for subordinates to perform effectively.



Some issues raised in the mentor-mentee sessions:

• Difficulty with Course Material:

Students reported challenges in understanding certain course materials.

• Balancing Studies and Family:

Students expressed concerns about managing the balance between their academic responsibilities and family obligations.

• Time Management and Exam Patterns:

Students faced difficulties in managing their time during exams, especially after the introduction of new exam formats following the ceiling policy.

• Social Anxiety and Extracurricular Participation:

Some students felt hesitant to engage in extracurricular activities due to social anxiety.

• Challenges in Building Relationships:

Some students find it difficult to form relationships, particularly in a new environment.

Some issues resolved during the period were:

• Frequent Interactions for Support:

Regular interactions were held with the mentees to address both academic and non-academic concerns.

• Talent Day and Counseling Support:

A Talent Day was organized to encourage students to participate in extracurricular activities, boosting their confidence. Students in need of counseling were referred to the college counsellor.

• Resolution of Relationship Issues:

Issues related to maintaining healthy relationships among mentees were addressed and resolved.

• Drug Abuse Awareness Session:

An awareness session on drug abuse was conducted for the mentees to inform and educate them on the topic.

Solutions for the issues shared:

• Addressing Exam Concerns and Counseling Support:

Concerns related to internal exams were addressed, and students' confidence was boosted to help them face exams with assurance. Students requiring counseling were referred to the college counsellor. Issues related to peer pressure and stress were also resolved.

• Orientation and Scholarship Assistance:

An orientation session was conducted to introduce students to the various committees and cells operating within the college. Queries related to scholarships were addressed, and assistance was provided in submitting scholarship applications.

• Examination Fee and Application Assistance:

Issues regarding examination fees and application-related queries were resolved.

• Remedial Classes for Underperforming Students:

Remedial classes were organized for students who showed underwhelming performance in the internal exams to help improve their academic standing.
