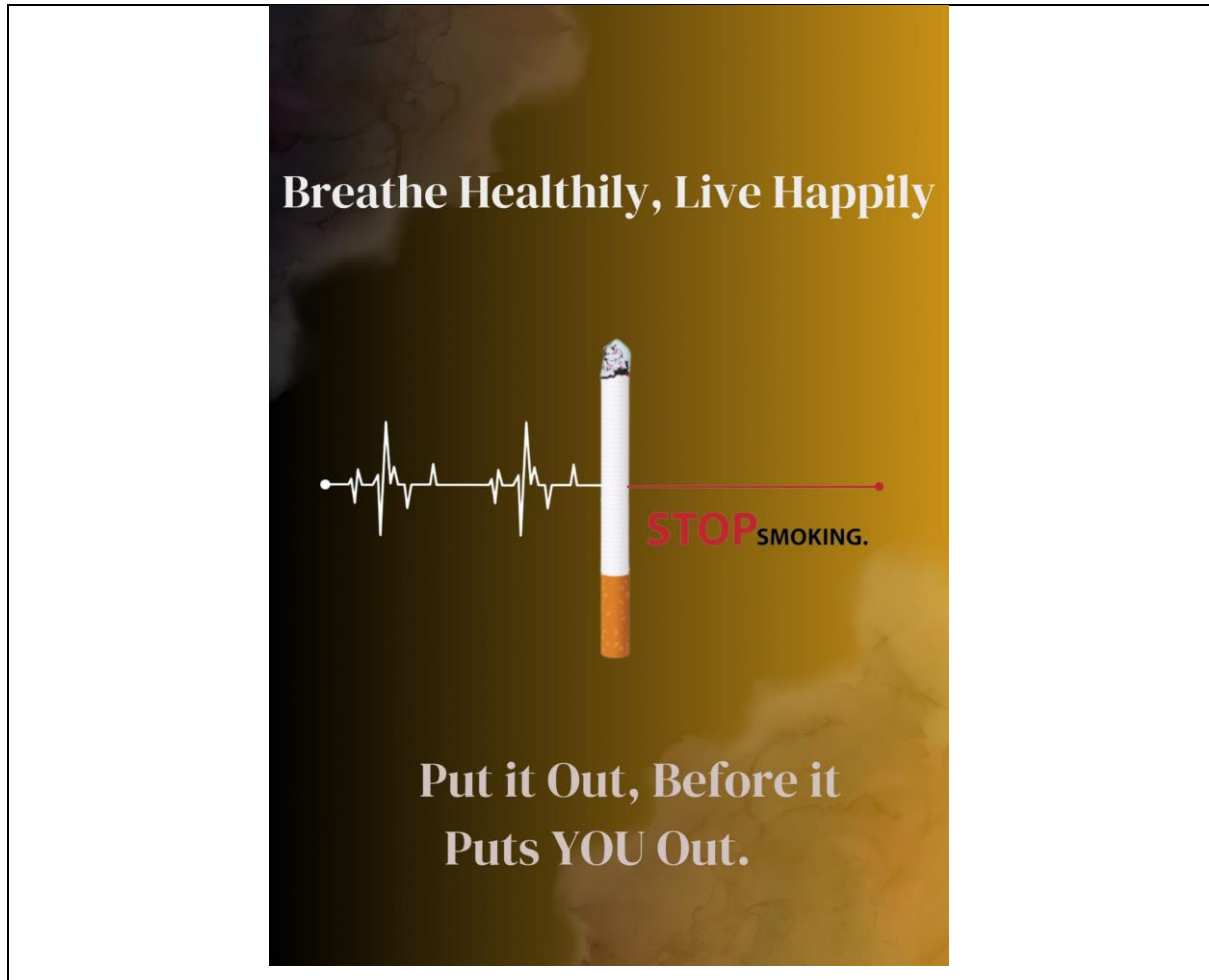
A digital poster making competition was conducted by the Personality Enrichment committee between October 03 and 16, 2023, on the topic "Breathe Life, Not Smoke."

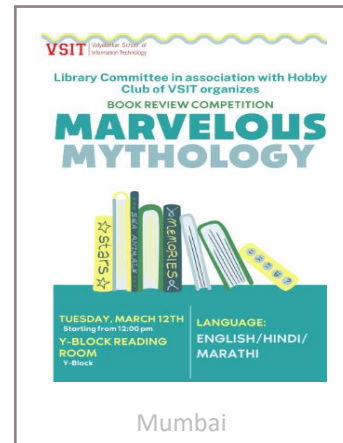

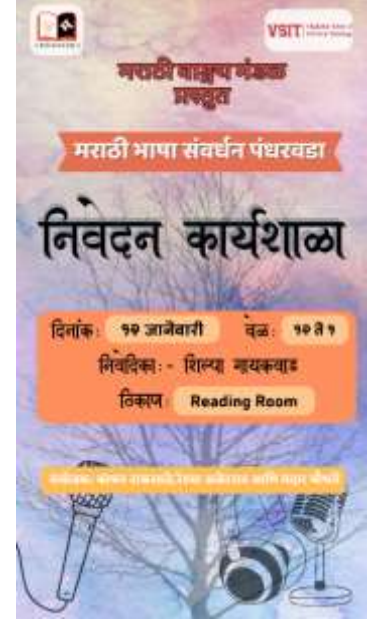

## Guest Lecture on Reporting Through RTI

### Main Report

A guest lecture was organized by the Department of Mass Media for the students of TYBAMMC Journalism on the topic “Reporting Through RTI and A Brief Look at Rafale Scam” The lecture commenced at 10:00 am and concluded at 11:00 am. The guest lecturer Mr Mandar Chaudhari is a faculty at VSIT. He holds a degree in Electronic Engineering and also in Political Science. He was awarded Junior Research Fellowship by UGC.

The lecture began with sir discussing students’ knowledge about the RTI Act and then sir himself gave an introduction of the topic. He showed at what different levels the RTI Act functions. Sir proceeded with demonstrating the correct way of applying for a government document through RTI’s online portal. Furthermore, the online RTI structure was explained through a tree diagram. Sir also provided with well-known examples of journalists implementing RTI to uncover the government’s unexplained monetary transactions and other functions. Students also put forth examples of social issues where the RTI Act can be used as a tool to probe investigation and fact-checking.

Lastly, Sir listed exemptions of the RTI Act. Students were given an interesting assignment where each one had to implement RTI through the online platform to gain hands-on experience. In the next session, Sir shall delve into the topic of Rafale Scam.

Students got to learn more about RTI and developed a better understanding towards the concepts. 11 students attended the session.

Maam, gave a brief introduction to the audience and the session begun.</p> <p>Maam began the session by emphasizing about content writing in detail. Content writing is the process of planning, writing, and editing content typically for digital marketing purposes. The idea is to write content that informs, educates, and entertains your target audience to increase the chance they later become customers. It is one of the fastest growing platforms across. The goal of content writing is to use one's content to turn awareness into interest which will lead to more sales, which in turn will lead to referrals, maam added.</p> <p>Maam elaborated more on various types of content namely: - Business writing, feature writing ghost writing, report and research writing, SEO writing and many more. These are some of the writings which we experience on a daily basis. Maam stated that It is considered to be the heart of digital marketing. Without any content digital marketing is null and void. Maam stated that Content must be simple, precise and directly to the point. The readers should be able to grasp the content easily. Each and every sector we are engaged in, requires content writing. Maam demonstrated various examples which made the necessity of content writing more understandable.</p> <p>Maam also made us aware of the difference between a Copywriter and Content writer. Copywriter is something that urges the reader to take action on immediate basis. Moreover, it uses emotions to seal the deal, whereas content writer uses storytelling to bring business to life. It is a longer form of writing namely blogs, articles and more, ma'am justified. Lastly, ma'am gave us few key points to remember when writing content. These points were very informative and useful in nature. Overall, the session was very informative and students took a lot of takeaways from the session. Aysha, came upon stage and gave a vote of thanks to all the patients listeners and our fellow speaker and the crowd was dismissed.</p>

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## Highlights



The Department of BMS, in collaboration with TEAM ENACTUS, recently organized an insightful workshop on "JOURNALING." The workshop aimed to enlighten participants about the benefits and techniques of journaling as a tool for personal and professional development. Rajas Mahadik, a member of ENACTUS, commenced the session by introducing Mrs. Tanvi Utekar to the audience.

Ma'am initiated the session by providing a basic definition of journaling, emphasizing the act of recording thoughts, emotions, feelings, regrets, and personal growth in a planner or diary on a daily basis. She addressed the audience, asking how many felt their lives were complicated. With numerous hands raised, she connected life complications to the lack of planning and explained how daily journaling could help in tracking and simplifying one's life.

The session delved into the various purposes of journaling, including self-reflection, emotional intelligence, personal growth, stress reduction, and memory preservation. Ma'am introduced different forms of journaling such as traditional written journaling, gratitude journaling, bullet journaling, one-sentence journaling, and digital journaling. Scientific benefits of journaling were highlighted, encompassing cognitive function improvement, boosted immune function, enhanced sleep quality, reduced symptoms of depression, accelerated healing, and better understanding of oneself.

Ma'am underscored the importance of addressing and noting down emotions. She further explained the significance of setting daily goals, documenting them, and working towards achieving yearly goals. A practical activity was conducted, where students were asked to write one goal for the year, list five requirements to achieve it, and note three things they were grateful for. This hands-on exercise provided students with practical knowledge about the art of journaling.

Continuing the session, Ma'am shared her personalized planner, featuring sections such as gratitude lists, positive life changes, happiest childhood memories, qualities appreciated about oneself, areas for improvement, short-term and long-term goals, and envisioning an ideal life. The planner also included daily mood trackers, expense trackers, habits trackers, water intake trackers, and monthly goals related to health, career, and finances. A special section was dedicated to listing books to read, web series to watch, and places to visit during the month.

In conclusion, Ma'am shared her personal journey with journaling, revealing that it took her two years to establish consistency. She highlighted the positive impact on her life, including building rapport with students and managing anger issues effectively.
