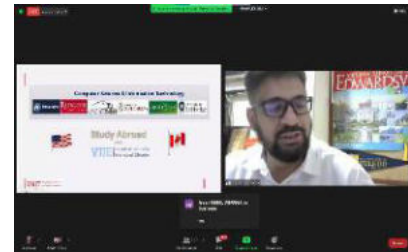


Microsoft, Google and Oracle was emphasized. The other highlights that are mentioned was V-Shield Poster competition and Hackathon.

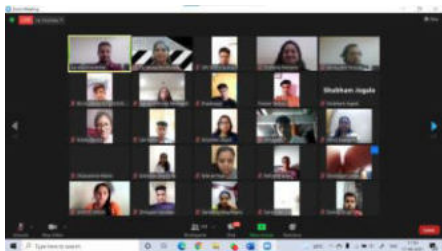
