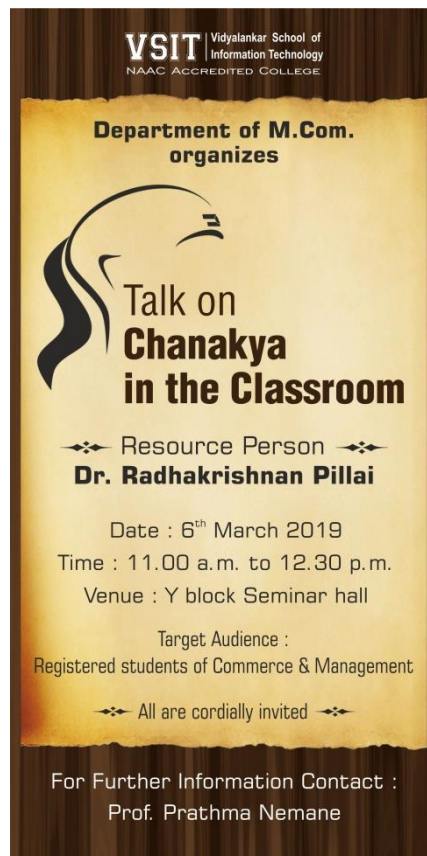
Dept. of M.com planned a session on CHANAKYA IN THE CLASSROOM by

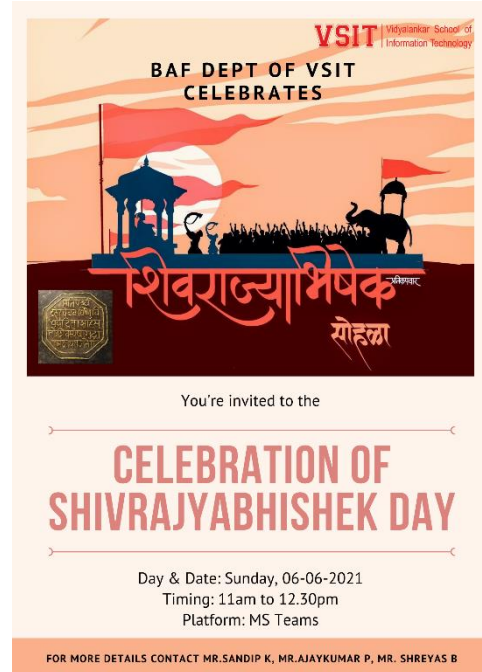

B.Com. Accounting & Finance Dept had organized a session on “Celebration of Shivrajyabhishek Day” for students and faculty of VSIT. This session was organized on the day of Coronation of the Great Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. On 06th June, 1974 the founder of the Maratha Empire, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was formally crowned as the Chhatrapati (emperor) of his realm at Raigad.

The session was started by Mr.Shreyas Bondre, who elaborated about the event which proved to be a milestone in Maratha history as it also marked the beginning of Hindavi Swarajya in India. Every year the day is celebrated in Maharashtra, especially in Raigad where people organise a coronation ceremony for Shivaji at Raigad Fort.

The session was further taken over by Mr. Sandip who started with some facts about the warrior king. He has explained the journey of Shivaji Maharaj, right from his childhood days and how his mother Jijabai, a fierce warrior and administrator, was instrumental in Shivaji’s quests to establish the Maratha Empire. She served as the queen regent in her son’s kingdom for which she is commonly known as Rajmata Jijabai. Shivaji Maharaj was a skilled commander and valiant warrior. He was extremely skilled at guerrilla-style warfare and planned stealthy war operations. He was often referred to as the ‘mountain rat’ for his art of stealthy warfare.

The session was concluded by saying that the youth of today should learn the qualities such as leadership skills, effective organizer, efficient strategist, skillful diplomat, bravery, respect for others, obedient son, all these were possessed by then great Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. Later Dr.Swagatika Nanda gave the vote of thanks for the session.



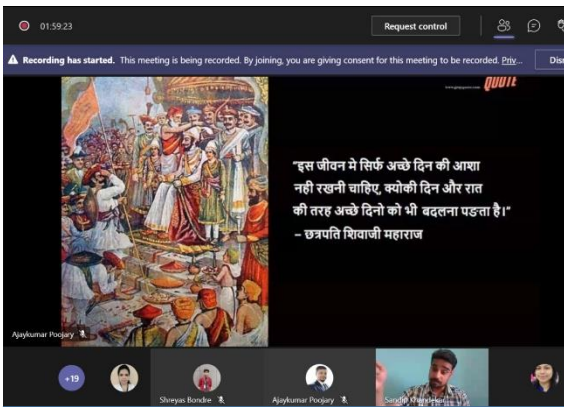
