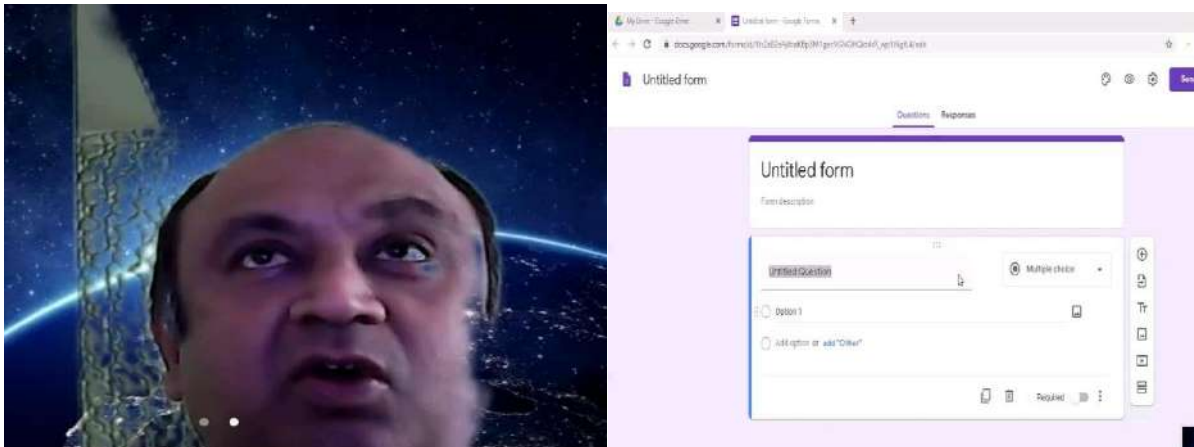
Day5 (3rd May 2022)
