

Machine Learning Solutions

Mr. Sushil Akhare, Senior Data Scientist at Walmart in Bentonville, Arkansas, USA, explained machine learning lifecycle. Collecting data, Data preparation, Data wrangling, Analysing data, Training model, testing model, and Deployment are the seven steps of the lifecycle. He provided examples of how machine learning methods are used in various domains such as sales/profit forecasting and retail store management (using image processing to separate out the rotten vegetables and fruits and clustering to categorise a new product)
