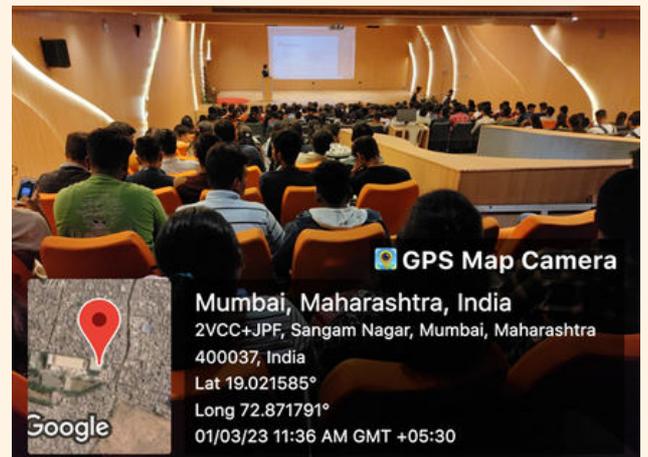

### VAC: Microsoft Data Analyst Associate

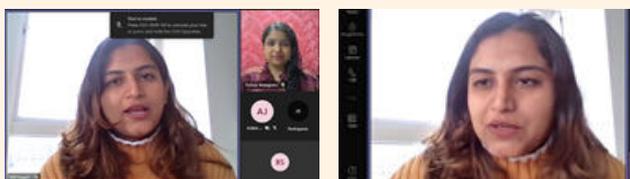

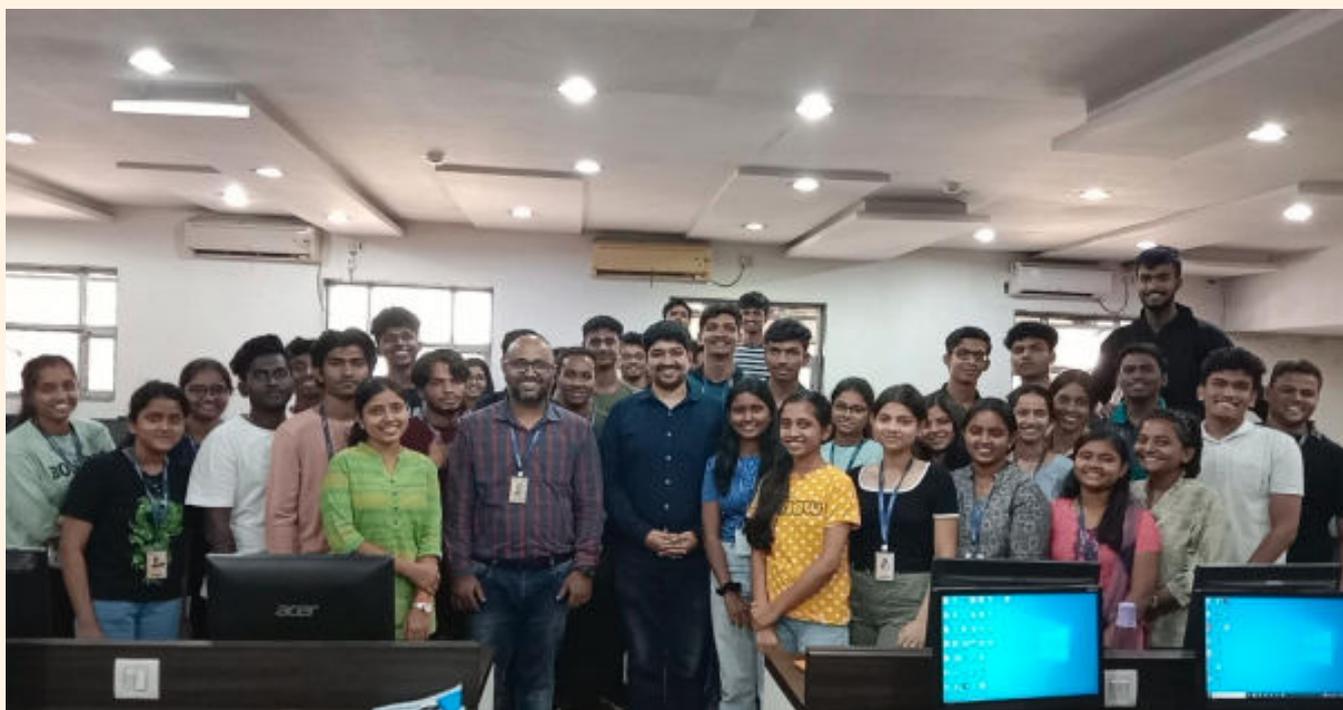


## Workshop: Industry Application of R Programming

### *Software Development Cluster*

A workshop on Industry Application of R Programming was organised for FY Data Science students on March 4, 2023 from 12:30 pm to 3:30 pm. 52 students participated in the workshop. Mr. Kedar Kelkar, Consultant - PwC India, Economist- was the resource person. The agenda of this workshop was to impart exposure to the skills of analyzing data in R available to make useful inferences that help in further decision-making. Before starting up with the actual analysis on data, students were brushed up with the basics of R language - including the importing of data files in R. This way they were prepped up for the analysis on actual data.

Students performed some conversions of data to a suitable data format, for further analysis. The analysis was centred around Household consumption expenses. Some functions were used to find central limits of data. This leads to the output of data, which leads to some insights on household consumption expenses. Then some techniques (functions) were used to create visualizing charts, that provide more insights on data. At the end, Regression analysis was performed to evidently predict that as the number of people in the household increase, the overall household consumption expenses also increase. For this regression analysis, the outlier data, i.e. the data values after 95th quartile were converted to the values equal to 95th quartile. This ensured that the regression analysis would work successfully. After regression analysis, the Resource Person answered questions asked by students pertaining to functionalities and scope of R. This workshop was appreciated by students, as they were able to perform real analysis on data first-hand.

### IV: NSE

#### *Banking and Insurance*

A study visit to “National Stock Exchange” was organised for FY BBI students to provide them a glimpse of how the stock and securities market works, as well as the basic guidance needed for stepping into the world of investments.
